

## Accessibility Statement

The Vickathon site enables hosting virtual hackathons, in which participants work in teams on an online shared file. This file is common to every team and guides them when developing an idea for a venture/initiative during the hackathon.

We are aware of the requirements of the service accessibility regulations, including regulation 35, the main provisions of which are published on the Israeli Ministry of Justice website.

For people with disabilities, the Equal Rights Law must ensure that websites on the Internet are accessible to them.

We believe that providing equal access to people with disabilities, including students, parents, and teachers in the education system, is of utmost importance and work to achieve this.

It follows the accessibility guidelines of Israeli standard 5568 - "Guidelines for accessibility of content on the Internet" at level AA.

The site is compatible with standard browsers and cell phones.

In order to ensure compatibility with surfers, Vickathon has been built to be as user-friendly as possible. Website layouts are responsive and adapt to different screen sizes.

We invest ongoing efforts in improving the Vickathon's accessibility as part of our commitment to allow its use for the entire population, including people with disabilities. However, there may still be a part of the website or information that has not yet been updated with accessibility adjustments, due to technical or other limitations.
